I, Jennifer Keough, hereby declare and state as follows: 1 1. I am the Chief Executive Officer and President of JND Legal 2 Administration LLC ("JND"). As the CEO and President of JND, I oversee all 3 facets of our company's operations, including monitoring and implementing our 4 notice and claims administration programs. This Declaration is based on my 5 personal knowledge as well as upon information provided to me by experienced 6 JND employees, and if called upon to do so, I could and would testify competently 7 thereto. 8 2. This Declaration describes the implementation of the Notice Program,¹ 9 as outlined in my August 2, 2024 Declaration on Settlement Notice Program (ECF) 10 941-3, the "Initial Declaration"), and provides an update on the claims 11 administration process. The Notice Program is ongoing and was designed to reach 12 virtually all settlement Class Members to inform them of the proposed Settlement 13 and their rights and options. 14 15 CAFA NOTICE 3. On August 12, 2024, JND mailed notice of the Mitsubishi Airbag 16 Control Unit Settlement to the United States Attorney General and to the 17 appropriate State officials pursuant to Class Action Fairness Act of 2005. 18 **DIRECT NOTICE** 19 20 **Class Member Identification** A. To prepare direct notice to Class Members, JND obtained the Vehicle 4. 21 Identification Numbers (VINs) for each of the Mitsubishi Class Vehicles and 22 contact information for potential Class Members. Defendants provided JND with 23 data that identified 94,785 unique Mitsubishi Class Vehicle VINs. The files from 24 25 the Defendants also included customer contact (email and mailing address) and Mitsubishi Class Vehicle information, among other information. 26 27 28

Using the Mitsubishi Class Vehicle VIN data, JND staff worked with a
 third-party data aggregation service to acquire vehicle registration information from
 the state Departments of Motor Vehicles ("DMVs") for all fifty states and U.S.
 Territories. This data compiled the contact information for all current and former
 owners and lessees of the Mitsubishi Class Vehicles, and enabled JND to further
 identify potential Class Members.

6. JND combined, analyzed, de-duplicated and standardized the data that
it received from the Defendants and the DMVs to provide individual notice to
virtually all settlement Class Members.

7. JND promptly loaded the VINs and potential Class Member contact
information into a case-specific database for the Settlement. A unique identification
number was assigned to each Class Member to identify them throughout the
administration process.

8. JND reviewed the email addresses received from the Defendants' data
to identify any undeliverable email addresses and duplicate records. Furthermore,
JND used the United States Postal Service ("USPS") National Change of Address
("NCOA") database² to obtain the most current mailing address information for
potential Class Members.

B. <u>Direct Email Notice</u>

9. The direct email notice campaign commenced on December 31, 2024.
 JND emailed notice to all potential Class Members for whom JND obtained a valid
 email address through the Defendants. The Email Notice included the same
 language as the court-approved Email Notice (ECF 941-3, Exhibit B). JND
 customized the Email Notice to include the potential Class Member's name and
 VIN. The Email Notice contained links to the Settlement Website and directed the

potential Class Member to visit the website to get more information and submit
 their settlement claim.

10. As of January 27, 2025, JND sent a total of 86,220 Email Notices, of
which 10,988 bounced back and were not deliverable. Based on JND's experience
in other cases, this non-deliverable rate of 12.7% is typical. As described below,
JND supplemented the direct email notice campaign by sending Postcard Notices to
the Class Members whose email notices bounced back as undeliverable.

11. The Email Notice as sent is attached as **Exhibit A**.

9

C. <u>Direct Mail Notice</u>

12. JND supplemented the direct email effort by sending a Postcard Notice 10 to all potential Class Members for whom an Email Notice bounced back as 11 undeliverable, or for whom a valid email address was not obtained. The Postcard 12 Notice included the same language as the court-approved Postcard Notice (ECF, 13 941-3, Exhibit C). JND customized the Postcard Notice to include the potential 14 Class Member's name, address, and VIN. The Postcard Notice provided the 15 Settlement Website URL and a QR code that directly linked to the Settlement 16 Website. Potential Class Members were directed to visit the Settlement Website to 17 get more information and submit their settlement claim. 18

Pursuant to the schedule set forth in the Court's Preliminary Approval
 Order (ECF 983 at 25), JND has completed the Direct Mail Notice as of January 27,
 2025 and has sent the Postcard Notices to 191,254 potential Class Members.

14. The Postcard Notice as sent is attached as **Exhibit B**.

15. For any potential Class Member who had more than 10 VINs
associated with their name and address, JND sent a cover letter that included
language from the Postcard Notice to advise them of the process to submit a bulk
claim for more than 10 Mitsubishi Class Vehicles. As of January 27, 2025, JND has
sent bulk claim notices to 1,236 potential Class Members.

16. The cover letter as sent with the bulk claim notices is attached as Exhibit C.

SUPPLEMENTAL DIGITAL NOTICE

Digital Campaign A.

As detailed in the Initial Declaration, JND supplemented the direct 17. notice effort with a four-week digital campaign that ran through the Google Display Network ("GDN"), Facebook, and Instagram.

Prior to launching the digital effort, JND provided GDN, Facebook, and 18. 8 Instagram with Class Member data containing phone numbers, postal addresses, 9 and/or emails. GDN then matched the provided Class data with their own first-party 10 data which they collect through Gmail, YouTube, Chrome registrations, etc. Likewise, 11 Facebook and Instagram matched the provided data with their account user data. All 12 matches were utilized to create a "Custom Audience" list. Ads were then served to the 13 Custom Audience while they are active on GDN, Facebook, and Instagram over the 14 course of the campaign. 15

The digital ads include an embedded link to the Settlement Website, 19. 16 where potential Class Members can get more information about the Settlement and 17 file a claim online. A total of 2,241,104 digital impressions were served from 18 December 31, 2024 through January 26, 2025.³ The digital effort is scheduled to 19 end today, January 27, 2025. 20

Screenshots of the digital notices as they appeared on GDN, Facebook, 20. 21 and Instagram are attached as **Exhibit D**. 22

21. Additional efforts were implemented through iHeart Automotive 23 Connection ("IAC"). JND provided IAC with the make, model, and year of the 24 Mitsubishi Class Vehicles. IAC then pulled their VIN data that matched the 25

Mitsubishi Class Vehicle information. On January 17, 2025, IAC began to deploy 1 email notices to their list of customers associated with the Mitsubishi Class Vehicle 2 information.⁴ IAC also deployed a follow-up email notice on January 22, 2025 to 3 those email recipients who opened the January 17, 2025 email notice for no 4 additional cost.⁵ A total of 100,000 IAC email notices were sent during the initial 5 email deployment. The total number of emails sent for the follow-up email 6 deployment is pending. 7 The IAC email notices as sent are attached as **Exhibit E**. 22. 8 23. As of January 26, 2025, the supplemental digital effort served 9 2,341,104 impressions, 641,104 more than originally planned. 10 11 **Internet Search Campaign** B. 24. From December 31, 2024 through January 27, 2025, JND caused 12 9,911 additional impressions to be served through an internet search campaign. 13 When purchased keywords/phrases related to the Settlement (e.g., content on the 14 Settlement Website landing page) were searched, a paid Responsive Search Ad 15 ("RSA") with a hyperlink to the Settlement Website would sometimes appear on 16 the search engine results page. When the RSA was clicked on, the visitor was 17 redirected to the Settlement Website where they could get more information about 18 the Settlement. The search effort was monitored and optimized for 19 keywords/phrases that resulted in the best click-throughs/conversions. 20 Screenshots of the RSAs as they appeared online are attached as 25. 21 Exhibit F. 22 23 24 ⁴ IAC deploys emails on a "drip" system to avoid white labeling (spam). It can take up to five days to fully deploy. 25 ⁵ The original IAC effort included banners ads being served via GDN to those potential Class Members who opened their IAC Email Notice; however, IAC has ceased implementing the GDN 26 effort. Instead, IAC agreed to send a follow-up Email Notice deployment on January 22, 2025. In addition, the digital impressions that were to be served over GDN through IAC have been shifted 27 to the original GDN, Facebook, and Instagram effort. Therefore, the overall digital impression 28 delivery will remain the same, and an IAC follow-up Email Notice was deployed for no additional

cost.

26. JND caused a press release to be distributed on December 31, 2024 to over 5,000 media outlets nationwide. As of January 27, 2025, the press release was picked up 504 times with a potential audience of 187.8 million.

SETTLEMENT WEBSITE AND OTHER CLASS MEMBER NOTICE

A. <u>Settlement Website</u>

28. On November 11, 2024, JND launched an interactive, case-specific 8 Settlement Website at www.ACUSettlement.com. The Settlement Website was 9 listed in the direct notices and accessible through the Email and digital Notices, as 10 well as the Postcard Notice QR code. The website provides comprehensive 11 information about the Settlement, including answers to frequently asked questions 12 ("FAQs"), contact information for the Settlement Notice and Claims Administrator, 13 key dates, including the deadlines to file a claim, request exclusion, and object, and 14 links to important case documents, including the Long Form Notice, the Mitsubishi 15 Class Vehicle List, the Claim Form, and the Settlement Agreement. 16

17 29. In addition, the Settlement Website provides a VIN Lookup feature,
18 where potential Class Members can input their VIN to determine whether their
19 vehicle may be eligible for compensation under the Settlement Agreement.

30. The Settlement Website also features an online Claim Form with
document upload capabilities for the submission of claims. Additionally, as noted
above, a Claim Form is posted on the Settlement Website for download for those
Class Members who prefer to submit a Claim Form by mail.

31. As of January 27, 2025, the Settlement Website has tracked a total of
14,772 unique users who registered 17,654 page views. JND will continue to
update and maintain the Settlement Website throughout the settlement
administration process.

REQUESTS FOR EXCLUSION

39. The Notices also informed Class Members of their right to opt out of 4 the Settlement and the February 27, 2025 postmark deadline to do so. As of January 5 27, 2025, JND has received or is otherwise aware of zero requests for exclusion. 6 Not later than 10 days before the date of the Fairness Hearing, JND will prepare 7 and provide to Counsel a list of those persons who have excluded themselves from 8 the Settlement. 9

NOTICE DESIGN AND CONTENT

40. The notice documents were designed to comply with Rule 23's 11 guidelines for class action notices and the FJC's Judges' Class Action Notice and 12 Claims Process Checklist and Plain Language Guide. The notices contained easy-13 to-read summaries of the instructions on how to obtain more information about the 14 case and direct potential Class Members to the Settlement website, where the Long 15 Form Notice and other case documents are posted. Courts routinely approve notices 16 that have been written and designed in a similar manner. 17

The cash compensation available will be <u>up to \$250 for each Mitsubishi Class Vehicle</u>, with the potential for additional payments of unclaimed funds, depending on the volume of claims submitted and court-awarded fees and costs. If multiple Class Members submit a valid claim for the same Mitsubishi Class Vehicle, 60% of the compensation for that Mitsubishi Class Vehicle will be allocated to the original owner who purchased the vehicle new, and the remaining 40% will be allocated to or divided evenly among the other Class Member(s).

In addition to the cash payments, the Settlement provides for a robust Mitsubishi Class Vehicle inspection program. Please visit **www.ACUSettlement.com** for more information.

How do I get a payment?

You must submit a claim to receive a cash payment. The claim form asks for basic information and takes just a few minutes to complete.

To submit your claim online, Visit <u>www.Acusettlement.cons</u>, you would like to submit your claim by mail, you can download and print the claim form on the Settlement Website or call to request a form. The fastest option is to submit your claim online.

You should submit your claim now.

Claim forms must be electronically submitted or postmarked no later than <u>May 8, 2026</u>. This schedule may change, so please visit the Settlement Website regularly for updates.

What are my other options?

You may object to or exclude yourself from the Settlement by February 27, 2025.

If you exclude yourself, you will not receive any cash payments and you will not release any of the claims that this Settlement resolves. If you do not exclude yourself from the Settlement, you will be bound by the Court's orders and judgments like all other Class Members, even if you do not file a claim.

If you wish to object, the Court will consider your views in deciding whether to approve or reject this Settlement. If the Court does not approve the Settlement, no cash payments will be sent, and the lawsuit will continue. You cannot object if you exclude yourself from the Settlement.

What happens next?

The Court will hold a hearing on **April 7, 2025** at 8:30 a.m., to consider whether to grant final approval of the Settlement, award fees and costs to the attorneys representing the Class, and service awards to the Settlement Class Representatives. Co-Lead Counsel will ask the Court to award up to 30% of the Settlement Amount (i.e. up to \$2.55 million) to cover reasonable attorneys' fees plus costs they incurred in litigating this case and securing this nationwide Settlement for the Class. Co-Lead Counsel will also ask the Court to award each of the 4 proposed Settlement Class Representatives a service award of up to \$2,500

each for their work in this litigation. You do not need by alleng this hearing, but you are welcome to attend at your own expense. The hearing date may change, so please check the Settlement Website regularly for updates.
